

RESOLUTION #1-2015

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RELOCATION ORDER AND ROW PLAT
FOR THE BORG ROAD BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Delavan applied for DOT grant funding in 2011 to repair or replace the failing Borg Road Bridge. The existing bridge is currently posted for a maximum weight load of 15-tons due to structural problems. The current City and Town Boundary Limits meet at the center of this bridge making this a joint construction project with the City of Delavan. A DOT grant has been awarded funding 80% of the design and construction cost for this bridge reconstruction project with the remaining 20% cost shared equally between the City and Town; and

WHEREAS, In order to reconstruct the Borg Rd. Bridge over Swan Creek, in conformance with Federal Design Standards, the area of construction disturbance will extend beyond the width of the current 66-foot wide Public Right-of-Way. Any needed Right-of-Way acquisition cost is a 100% local cost shared equally with the City of Delavan and not eligible for grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town of Delavan Board approves the Relocation Order and Final Plat dated 2-16-15 necessary to acquire any easements and Public Right-of-Way to complete this project.
